Mathematics - Term 2

Maths Mania – The Amazing Race – Monday – Week 7

Thank you to all the parents and students who braved the freezing cold to participate in our Maths Mania Amazing Race.

We completed 4 activities that involved hard mathematics thinking. They involved cutting doughnuts, counting legs of animals, making rectangular prisms and making matchstick houses!



The students at Holy Trinity have been working on rich tasks in class. Here are some examples:

Kindergarten



Stage 1

Kindergarten have been learning to measure the area of closed shapes. They have also been creating and continuing patterns with shapes, objects and numbers.

Stage 1 completed an investigation called, **How to make smiley face biscuits.**

We had to calculate how many ingredients we would need if we were to make 2 biscuits each. We had to do lots of hard thinking to work out how many packets we would need. We also estimated how many ingredients were in each packet. We also put our biscuits into arrays. After a week of hard work, we finally got to make the biscuits and they were yummy!



Stage 2	Stage 3
<p>Stage 2 has been investigating area and perimeter. We have been looking at different ways of measuring the classroom and the playground. We have estimated, drawn, labelled and calculated real life examples of area and perimeter. We have used arrays and partial arrays as warm up activities.</p> 	<p>Stage 3 have been investigating a rich task about a theatre. A theatre has a capacity of 450 seats. How many rows might there be? How many seats in each row might there be? Students had to draw up a seating plan using a partial array to show their thinking.</p>

We aim to build children's confidence in making and maintaining friendships through teaching conversational rules and practising them in a safe environment.

The program includes an assessment session and individual, paired and group therapy sessions.
