On Wednesday that week we will have more fun learning about Maths with “World of Maths” for all grades.

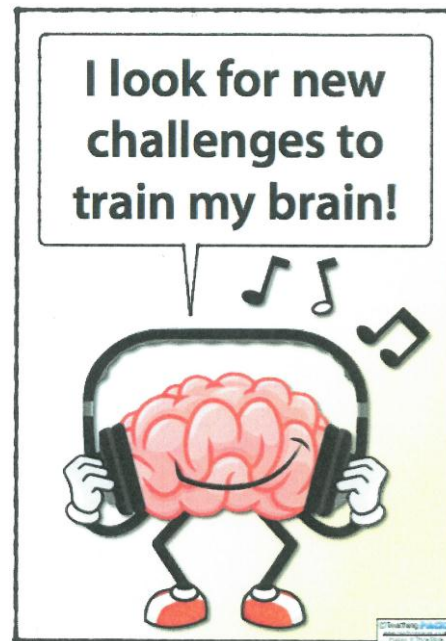
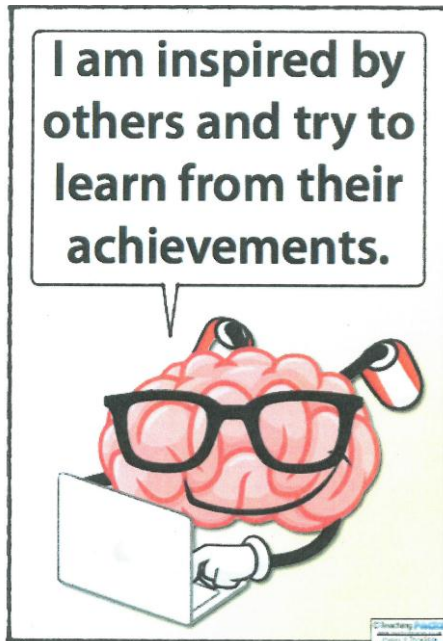
On Friday our Stage 3 children will enjoy a concert at the Riverside theatre entitled Music in Sport, presented by the Sydney Symphony Orchestra.
