### **Our Catholic Faith**

Today I have included an image from 'Understanding Faith' that symbolises the Sacraments of Initiation in the Catholic Church.

#### *Sacraments of Initiation*

*'Look at the picture called Sacraments of Initiation. The blue waves are water. They stand for the Sacrament of Baptism. Can you spot the dove? The dove is the Holy Spirit. It stands for the Sacrament of Confirmation. We also picture the Holy Spirit as tongues of fire. The bread and the cup with wine stand for the Sacrament of the Eucharist. These sacraments are Sacraments of Initiation. We need these sacraments to begin our full friendship with Jesus. We can only be baptised and confirmed once. However, we can celebrate the Sacrament of the Eucharist many times. Catholics usually celebrate the Sacrament of the Eucharist each Sunday at Mass.*

Dear Parents and Carers,

This year, our Holy Trinity Mathematics focus is on Multiplication and Division. Our staff are currently learning about better ways to teach multiplicative thinking by using a variety of teaching methods. Stage 2 students are participating in a study looking at their multiplicative thinking strategies.

Attached is an article on arrays that our teachers have read. By using arrays, students can link multiplication and division strategies. Arrays promote students' understandings of mental computation strategies for multiplication. They also provide a range of different examples that illustrate the benefits of arrays in the primary classroom.

We hope that when your children are presenting their student-led conferences during our *Celebration of Learning*, they show you their mathematical thinking. By using mental warm ups and rich, open-ended tasks in, our students are thinking “*outside the square*” and extending their mathematical thinking every day.
