Next year, Holy Trinity's learning focus will be:

Religious Education: That students will continue to develop their understanding of Scripture through service to others in the school and wider community.

English: Students will improve their comprehension skills as evidenced by two clusters (K-2) and one cluster (3-6) on the DEC Literacy Continuum (Comprehension & Reading Texts).

Mathematics: To move 1 growth point across all domains school-wide, with an accelerated growth in Multiplication and Division. *(There will also be a focus on vulnerable students and their accelerated growth in all G.Ps)*

These goals are based on school and CEDP data and are continuations of the 2016 goals. This means that our teachers will be working hard to improve student outcomes particularly in these areas. We will be offering parent workshops next year in these areas of focus, so that you can understand the work that we are doing.
