This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity.

Pope Gregory IX instituted Trinity Sunday in 828 CE. This day is known for being the only major Christian festival that celebrates a church doctrine rather than an event in its sacred history. It is dedicated to the Christian belief in the Trinity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – and falls on the Sunday following Pentecost each year.

Many Christian churches in Australia celebrate Trinity Sunday. It is an opportunity for the congregation to learn about or revisit the concept of the trinity, which refers to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit being one God.

The Nicene Creed, the sign of the Cross and our school prayer remind us of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

Each morning our students recite our school prayer a prayer that names and honours the Trinity and embodies our school motto.

Pray this prayer with your children.

God for us we call you Father, we love one another

God alongside us we call you Jesus, we serve one another

God within us we call you Holy Spirit, you give us hope.
