- Look for buses pulling out watch for flashing lights.
- Always park and turn legally around schools.
- Calling out to children from across the road is dangerous they may run to you without checking for traffic.
- Drop your children off and pick them up on the school side of the road.
- Always give way to pedestrians and always cross the road at the pedestrian crossing.
- It's safest for children to get out of the car on the kerb side of the road to be away from passing traffic.
