- make plans with the teacher about how you can both support your child
- build a relationship with your child's school

It is important for your child to be present for the interview so that they are aware what their learning strengths and challenges are. During the interview, your child will be asked to set a learning goal for English and Mathematics for the rest of the year.

Term 2 School fees are now overdue. Please make payment as soon as possible. If you are experiencing difficulty making this payment, please contact the office.


