Dear Parents and Friends.

Last newsletter I focused on our instructional leaders and intervention programs. Also a spotlight on Kindergarten and Stage 1.

This week I would like you to know about how we plan for students with additional needs. At HTG we have students on personalised plans which identify students who require adjustments to be made in their learning programs. We have case management meetings to identify the needs of children whose progress is slow.

Spotlight on Stage 2 and 3

This week **Stage 3** commenced a program called "Destination Imagination". This program is very exciting and students will work in teams to learn the skills of communication, collaboration, work ethic, critical thinking and research to develop a project. Watch out for information in term 4 when they will present their first project. We are pleased to be able to share this learning with students from Delany College who will be part of the teams.



Our stage three teachers have recently had three days with Steve Zipkes from USA who shared his knowledge of project based learning. The first PBL topic will be focused on Factors that Shape Places. Stage 3 teachers are trying to organise for a town planner from Cumberland council to launch this project with the children. Students in stage 3 have continued to share "Prayer Pair" with their classes on a fortnightly basis and the students have responded with confidence and enthusiasm due to the ownership/leadership that this activity entails. Year 5 are currently studying The Story of my Parish and Year 6 are studying Sacraments of Service.

Stage 2

The highlight for many of our stage 2 children this week was their participation in the CAPTIVATE SHOWCASE. Along with 1800 other students from our diocese these children demonstrated commitment and talent. I am sure these performances will remain in their memories for many years to come. Thank you to the teachers and parents who supported this event.







For the last 2 weeks and the next 2 weeks Stage 2 and 3 have been receiving coaching in basketball. This has been possible because we received a grant from Sporting Schools. In term 4 stage 3 will have the opportunity to compete in a basketball gala day in Penrith.

At Holy Trinity we provide a variety of learning which is so important for the development of the whole child. Some children are all rounders and achieve at all things while others are better at academics or sports or creative arts. We work hard to make sure we cater for the needs of all our children

Dance Fever Challenge will take place for Stage 2 and 3 on Friday 21st September. Please consider allowing your child to participate as this is another experience they will not forget. More information will be sent home. We are defending our championship win from last year.

Keeping Our Children Safe
