Notice required Before Moving Students from School


10 school weeks in Writing must be given to the principal before removal of a student or a full term's fees will be payable.

The gospel extract for this week is the classic story of the doubting Thomas who was not present when the risen Jesus first appeared to his friends. Jesus appears on the first day of the Jewish week, which is Sunday, and the first thing he offers his friends is peace. Notice there is not a hint of the fact that the disciples ran out on Jesus when he was arrested. There is no blame or any recrimination coming from the Prince of Peace.

We can see that resurrection not only applies to Jesus but it is a spiritual reality that occurs in our own lives. Every act of forgiveness is a new start and every reconciliation is a renewal of relationship that becomes a kind of resurrection to new life.
