At Holy Trinity we aim to provide a safe environment for all the students. Safety does not just mean keeping the children free from physical harm. It also means keeping the children safe emotionally. Part of keeping a safe school environment is the expectation of the use of appropriate language. There have been several incidents lately of students using inappropriate language at school. At Holy Trinity inappropriate language is not acceptable and we ask for all parents and carers to support us by having a conversation with your children about using appropriate language at school.

Being Brave Show

On Tuesday the students at Holy Trinity watched a show about resilience called 'Being Brave'. Being Brave gave children strategies to deal with their emotions through good communication, persistence and positive self-talk - making them more resilient. This is important as everyone has challenges that they need to face.



Stage 3 Project Launch

On Tuesday, Stage 3 had a visit from Monica Cologna who is a Town Planner for Cumberland Council to launch the Geography Project - *How can we as town planners for the Cumberland council, create a display, so that we can inform and persuade our community about the influences people and environments have on one another and how these places are managed?*

Monica shared her experience as a town planner and showed projects that the council is currently working on in the local area. She also gave the school maps that the students can use for their projects.
