Dear Parents and Friends,

As a parent you work hard to protect your children. You warn them about stranger danger but keeping them safe online is a little more challenging. Each time your computer is connected to the Internet, danger could come flooding into your home.

The Internet is now an integral part of life so simply banning it is inappropriate. Instead, you can take some steps to minimize the dangers for your children.

- 1. Keep the computer that is connected to the Internet in shared family spaces rather than bedrooms so that you can monitor its use and also be available if your children want to talk about anything they view that makes them feel uncomfortable.
- 2. Set some guidelines for use such as:
 - <u>Never</u> give out personal information or your photo
 - Do not open email attachments from strangers or people they have met online
 - <u>Never</u> meet in person someone they have met online
- 3. While supervision is the best defence against Internet danger, it is not possible to monitor children 24/7. The use of Internet software allows you to set controls over the information that your child sends or views. Some software even allows you to set time limits on how long your child can 'surf' the Net.

Check that your Internet Service Provider (ISP) is family-friendly and adheres to the Internet Industry Association codes of conduct. These ISPs can offer information and online tools to assist both parents and children to use the Internet in fun, yet safe ways.
