Term 4 Events: During Term 4 we have many opportunities to celebrate with our wonderful community. Please take note of the following events:

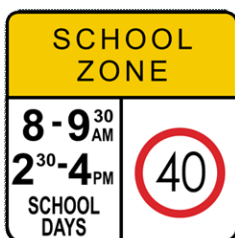
